**Guest Speaker:** Scott McGlashan, SPD at 7:20 pm

With 22 years of policing experience including being a diver for the Harbor Patrol, Scott started his assignment for Ballard, Crown Hill and “Freelard” area as one of 5 community officers out of the North Precinct in February 2011. One major area of concern for Scott has been the Ballard Library where they are considering the temporary installation of a camera to be tested as an overt prevention measure. His current major focus is implementing the reforms in SPD's 20/20 plan. He talked about “Alcohol Impact Areas” as being voluntary and issues with “Goon Squad” gang at Ballard High School. He encourages having meetings with community members in Ballard.
